Use of Funds: Pilot program

▶ **Description:** Plan a diabetes care education program in a regional free clinic setting.

▶ **Results:** CVFC developed a network of professional personnel who participate in the Community Diabetes Program, including physicians, diabetic educators, dieticians, and social workers. CVFC also developed a comprehensive program of care for patients with diabetes within the free clinic setting and piloted it through bi-monthly diabetes clinics they initiated. By the end of the project period, the population included 26 CVFC patients who received comprehensive evaluations, with approximately 1-2 new diabetic patients per week coming to the Free clinic for health services. CVFC also identified community services to which patients could be referred.

▶ **Met Objectives:** Partially met

▶ **Baseline Progress on SHP Objectives:** Not measured

▶ **Academic Partner Role:** Worked collaboratively academic partner to develop a plan for incorporating resident physician education experience in not only diabetic management, but also chronic disease management into the CVFC program.

▶ **Matched Dollars (cash or in-kind):** \$5,000

▶ **Dissemination:** Results, objectives and goals will be shared at the next conference presented by the American Association of Free Clinics.

▶ **Sustained:** Funding for the continuation and expansion of this program is dependent on financial support through grants and donations. Continuing to seek funding.
