



## **Wiscard – UW Madison Faculty/Staff ID**

*(This is in addition to your UW Health ID Badge)*

To obtain your [Wiscard](#) check with your Program Coordinator as he/she may have scheduled time during program orientation. The Wiscard provides access to campus libraries, [recreation facilities](#), and other campus services. The first Wiscard is issued at no cost. The card is valid for five years from the date of issue. Lost cards can be replaced for a \$25 fee.

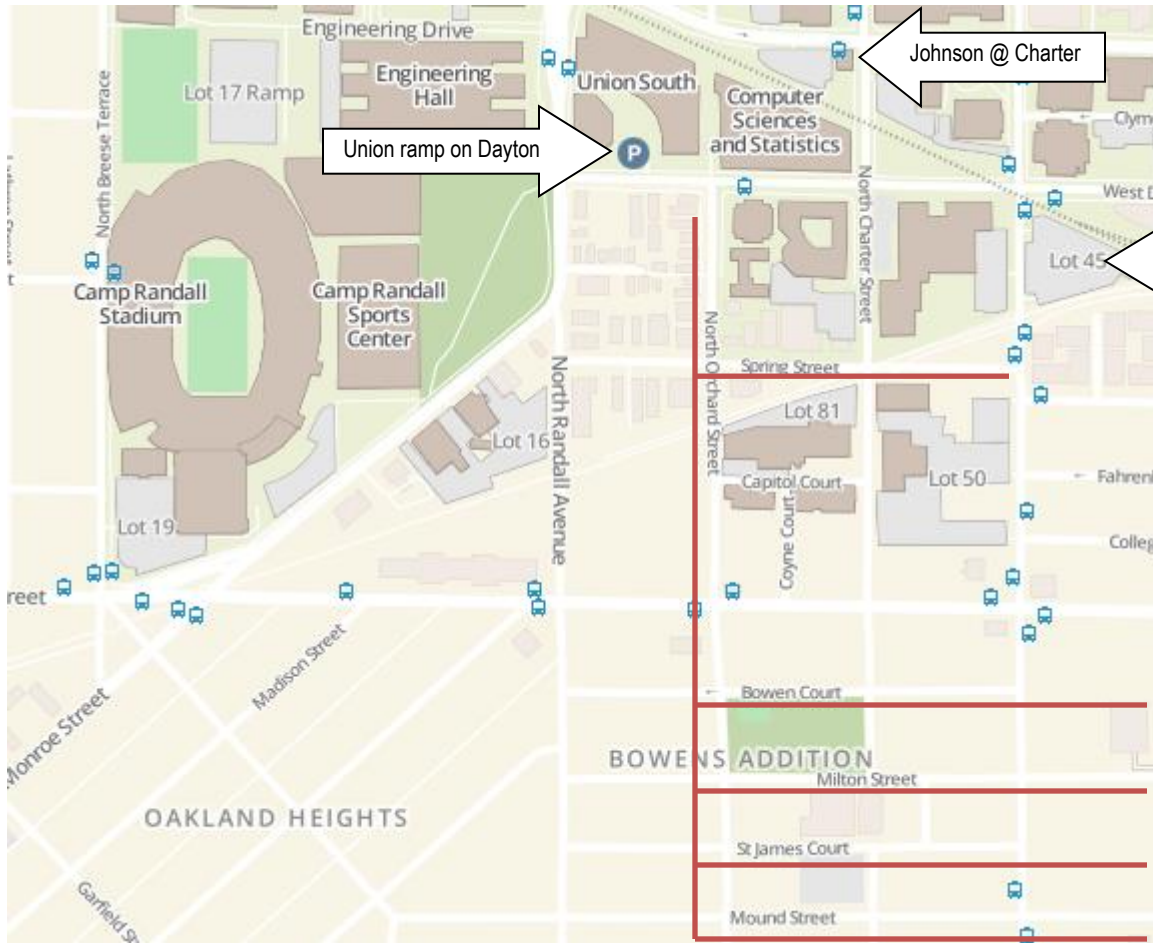
Bring identification that includes your picture and signature (i.e. **Driver's License or Passport**). The UW Health ID Badge is **not acceptable** identification.

- There is an hourly parking garage under Union South that is accessible from Dayton Street. University lots are also often free after 4:30 (there is a University lot on Mills Street and Spring Street a couple blocks away).
- Parking, in general, is very limited on campus. There is a possibility of free street parking in the residential areas just south of Union South (on Orchard Street and Spring Street, or if you follow Orchard farther south past Regent Street).
