

## MSTP: WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?



Thank you for accepting your interview with the University of Wisconsin-Madison Medical Scientist Training Program! We hope you will enjoy learning about our program during your visit and we are looking forward to meeting you and learning more about you. You might be wondering ...

### *Is there anything else to submit?*

No. You will have the opportunity during the interview to discuss any significant activities or events in your life since you submitted your application. The only additions that will be made to your application file are the interview reports and any additional research publication(s) that are accepted or published that you provide us. You may upload a copy of your research publication as a PDF document to the MSTP Secondary.

### *What about thank-you notes?*

### *How does the final review by the Admissions Committee work?*

Following your interview, your complete application file will undergo a final review by the University of Wisconsin School of Medicine and Public Health Admissions Committee to determine whether you will be **Accepted**,

placed on the **Alternate List** or **Not Accepted**. The Admissions Committee meets regularly and will complete the final review of your application as soon as possible after your interview.

### *How do you notify me? Can I check my status?*

You will be notified via email of the Admissions Committee's final decision regarding your application. **Please wait until at least two weeks after your interview to contact us about the status of your application.** If you do not receive a decision within the two weeks following your interview, please email us at [mstp@med.wisc.edu](mailto:mstp@med.wisc.edu) or call **608-262-0736** or **608-262-6321**. Accepted students will also receive a letter through the Secondary portal outlining the terms and conditions of the MSTP offer.

**Make sure to keep your mailing address, email address and phone number updated in AMCAS – under the Preferred section of your Contact Information.**

### *What if I receive an acceptance from another medical school or MD/PhD program?*

Per AAMC regulations, you may hold acceptances to multiple medical schools until **April 30, 2021**; by which time you must submit a statement of intent to the school of your choice and release your acceptances to all other schools.

## Will you be hosting a Second Visit?

Yes! All accepted students are invited to revisit with us in the spring. Both the MSTP and MD programs will host second visit events, either virtually or in person if feasible. You are welcome to attend one or both events, and can bring a significant other or parent too.

## What if I am on the Alternate List?

We do not rank our alternate list. The MSTP Admissions Subcommittee makes additional offers depending on many factors; we try to keep the incoming class balanced in terms of research interest, background and other applicant characteristics. You may receive an offer of acceptance from us at any time during the application cycle, but most offers to those on the alternate list are typically made in April or May.

\*Please keep a copy of the course syllabus and research paper for verification purposes. If we cannot verify that you have met this requirement you will be required to take an additional course before matriculating.

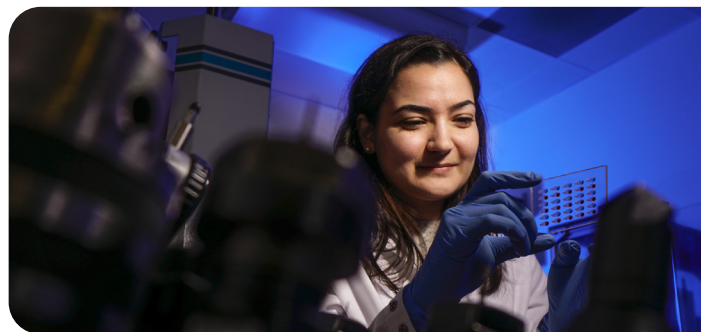
